A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ORGANIC AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that organic farmers face 2 unique challenges, particularly finding appropriate lands to 3 cultivate. The legislature also finds that many organic farmers would achieve more efficient crop production if they had greater 4 5 access to the latest advances in crop science and technology. 6 The high technology development corporation is ideally suited to 7 assist these farmers in implementing technological innovations 8 to maximize their chances of success. 9 The purpose of this Act is to allow the State to better **10** address the needs of our farmers. 11 SECTION 2. Chapter 141, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 12 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 13 and to read as follows: "\$141- Organic agricultural mobilization program; 14 15 established. (a) The department of agriculture shall establish 16 an organic agricultural mobilization program, under which the 17 department shall provide affordable long-term leases to farmers
- 18 to establish organic farms.

1	(b) The department shall identify lands under its
2	jurisdiction that are suitable to be leased to farmers pursuant
3	to this section.
4	(c) The department shall determine eligibility
5	requirements for participants in the organic agricultural
6	mobilization program; provided that participants shall be
7	organic farmers.
8	(d) Participants in the program may receive assistance
9	from the high technology development corporation in implementing
10	technological innovations for improved crop cultivation.
11	(e) The department may provide financial assistance to
12	participants of the organic agricultural mobilization program in
13	paying the costs of:
14	(1) Certification by a third party food auditor; and
15	(2) Modifications necessary to receive third party food
16	safety certification.
17	(f) The department shall adopt rules, pursuant to chapter
18	91, necessary to carry out the purposes of this section."
