

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILDREN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$130,000 or so much
3	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and the
4	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
5	2014-2015 to support the Honolulu zero to three court in a
6	variety of areas, such as the coordinator's transportation to
7	visit children and parents, emergency housing assistance, a
8	secure opening at a residential drug and alcohol facility that
9	will accommodate a mother and child, development and
10	implementation of an incentive program similar to the successful
11	model utilized in family drug court, training and professional
12	development of zero to three court team members and community
13	partners, and creation and utilization of an enhanced visitation
14	and parenting coaching site in leeward Oahu.
15	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department

of human services for the purposes of this Act.
