A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRONIC TRAFFIC CITATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and 3 to read as follows: ELECTRONIC CITATION PROGRAM 4 "PART 5 §291C-A Definitions. As used in this part: 6 "Electronic citation" means the process of transmitting 7 traffic, misdemeanor, or other citations and law enforcement 8 data via electronic means to the clerk of the court. 9 §291C-B Electronic citation surcharge. (a) In addition 10 to any other civil penalties ordered by the court, a person who 11 violates any provision under this chapter shall be ordered to 12 pay an electronic citation surcharge of \$5 unless the county in 13 which the citation was issued has, by ordinance, elected not to 14 be subject to this part. 15 The person shall pay the surcharge to the clerk of the (b) 16 court. The surcharge shall be deposited with the director of 17 finance who shall credit the surcharge to the electronic

Chapter 291, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 5 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately 6 designated and to read as follows: 7 "<u>§291-</u> Electronic citation surcharge. (a) In addition 8 to any other civil penalties ordered by the court, a person who 9 violates any provision under this part shall be ordered to pay 10 an electronic citations surcharge of \$5 unless the county in 11 which the citation was issued has, by ordinance, elected not to 12 be subject to this part. 13 (b) The person shall pay the surcharge to the clerk of the 14 court. The surcharge shall be deposited with the director of 15 finance who shall credit the surcharge to the electronic 16 citation special fund established under 291C-C." 17 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ 18 or so much 19 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 for start-20 up costs associated with the electronic citation program. 21 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 22 transportation for the purposes of this Act.

1 SECTION 4. In codifying the new sections added by section 2 1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute 3 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating 4 the new sections in this Act. SECTION 5. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 5 6 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 7 begun before its effective date. 8 SECTION 6. New statutory material is underscored. 9 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013. 10
