BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "\$387-2 Minimum wages. Except as provided in section 387-9 and this section, every employer shall pay to each 4 5 employee employed by the employer, wages at the rate of not less 6 than: \$6.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2003; 7 (1)8 (2)\$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2006; [and] 9 \$7.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2007[-]; (3) 10 \$8.25 per hour beginning July 1, 2014; (4) 11 \$9.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2015; and (5) 12 (6) \$10.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2016. 13 The hourly wage of a tipped employee may be deemed to be increased on account of tips if the employee is paid not less 14 than 25 cents below the applicable minimum wage by the 15 16 employee's employer and the combined amount the employee receives from the employee's employer and in tips is at least 50 17 18 cents more than the applicable minimum wage."
