A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BUDGET.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that public funds are
- 2 meant to further the public good and ensure that state
- 3 government operates efficiently and effectively. It is
- 4 imperative that state revenues be spent in a fiscally
- 5 responsible manner and that state agencies be held accountable
- 6 for their use of public funds.
- 7 The legislature further finds that the University of Hawaii
- 8 is exempt from certain budgetary oversights and controls, which
- 9 limits transparency and may cause difficulties in ensuring that
- 10 the university is properly accountable for its use of public
- 11 funds.
- 12 Consequently, the legislature finds and declares that the
- 13 manner in which the University of Hawaii manages the public
- 14 funds entrusted to it is a matter of statewide concern and
- 15 therefore under the legislature's purview pursuant to article X,
- 16 section 6 of the Hawaii state constitution.
- 17 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to:

1	(1)	Expand the department of budget and finance's
2		authority to modify and withhold the university's
. 3		planned expenditures; and
4	(2)	Require the university to receive legislative
5		authorization prior to any appropriation transfers or
6		changes between programs or agencies.
7	SECT	ION 2. Section 37-74, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8	amended b	y amending subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:
9	"(C)	The department of budget and finance shall:
10	(1)	Review each operations plan to determine:
11		(A) That it is consistent with the policy decisions
12		of the governor and appropriations by the
13		legislature;
14		(B) That it reflects proper planning and efficient
15		management methods; and
16		(C) That appropriations have been made for the
17		planned purpose and will not be exhausted before
18		the end of the fiscal year;
19		provided that the department of budget and finance
20		shall review the operations plan submitted by the
21		University of Hawaii solely for consistency with the
22		allotment ceilings established by the governor under

1		section 37-34, appropriations by the legislature, the
2		requirements of chapter 37D, and the status of
3		revenues to support operations plans for all state
4		programs;
5	(2)	Approve the operations plan if satisfied that it meets
. 6		the requirements under paragraph (1). Otherwise, the
7		department of budget and finance shall require
8		revision of the operations plan in whole or in part;
9		and
10	(3)	Modify or withhold the planned expenditures at any
11		time during the appropriation period if the department
12		of budget and finance finds that the expenditures are
13		greater than those necessary to execute the programs
14		at the level authorized by the governor and the
15		legislature, or that state receipts and surpluses will
16		be insufficient to meet the authorized expenditure
17		levels[; provided that the planned expenditures for
18		the University of Hawaii may be modified or withheld
19		only in accordance with sections 37-36 and 37-37].
20	(d)	No appropriation transfers or changes between programs
21	or agenci	es shall be made without legislative authorization;

(2) Except [with respect to appropriations to fund financing agreements under chapter 37D, the University of Hawaii shall have the flexibility to transfer appropriated funds and positions for the operating cost category among programs, among cost elements in a program, and between guarters, as applicable; except] with respect to appropriations to fund financing agreements under chapter 37D, the department of education shall have the flexibility to transfer appropriated funds and positions for the operating cost category among programs and among cost elements in a program, and between quarters, as applicable; and the Hawaii health systems corporation and its regional system boards shall have the flexibility to transfer special fund appropriations among regional system hospital facilities as applicable and as mutually agreed to by the corporation and the respective regional system board; provided that the Hawaii health systems corporation and the regional system boards shall maintain the integrity and services of each

1	,	individual regional system and shall not transfer
2		appropriations out of any regional system that would
3		result in a reduction of services offered by the
4		regional system, with due regard for statutory
5		requirements, changing conditions, the needs of the
6		programs, and the effective utilization of resources;
7		and
8	(3)	The [university and the] department of education shall
9		account for each transfer implemented under this
10		subsection in quarterly reports to the governor and
11		annual reports at the end of each fiscal year to the
12		legislature and the governor, which shall be prepared
13		in the form and manner prescribed by the governor and
14		shall include information on the sources and uses of
15		the transfer."
16	SECT	ION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17	and stric	ken.
18	SECT	ION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2525.
