A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE RESIDENTIAL LANDLORD-TENANT CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 521, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§521- Medical marijuana; tenant use; eviction. A
- 5 provision in a rental agreement allowing for eviction of a
- 6 tenant who has a valid certificate for the medical use of
- 7 marijuana as provided in section 329-123 in any form is void,
- 8 unless the rental agreement allows for eviction for smoking
- 9 tobacco and the medical marijuana is used by means of smoking;
- 10 provided that this section shall not apply where the articles of
- 11 incorporation, declaration, bylaws, administrative rules, house
- 12 rules, association documents, or a similar document of a
- 13 condominium property regime or planned community association
- 14 prohibits the medical use of marijuana."
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 17 begun before its effective date.

- 2 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2112.

Voids any rental agreement provision that allows for eviction of a tenant for using medical marijuana unless the agreement allows for eviction for smoking tobacco and the medical marijuana is smoked or where a condominium property regime or planned community association prohibits the medical use of marijuana. Effective July 1, 2112. (HB1503 HD1)
