A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHWAY SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 291C-137, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[{]\$291C-137[}] Mobile electronic devices. (a) No 4 person shall operate a motor vehicle while using a mobile 5 electronic device. 6 The use of a mobile electronic device for the sole 7 purpose of making a "911" emergency communication shall be an 8 affirmative defense to this law. 9 (c) No person under eighteen years of age shall operate a 10 motor vehicle while utilizing a hands-free mobile electronic 11 device, except for the sole purpose of making a "911" emergency 12 communication. 13 The following persons shall be exempt from subsection 14 (a): 15 (1) Emergency responders using a mobile electronic device 16 while in the performance and scope of their official **17** duties;

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1	(2)	Drivers using a two-way radio or a private Land Mobile
2		Radio System, within the meaning of title 47 Code of
3		Federal Regulations part 90, while in the performance
4		and scope of their work-related duties and who are

7	(3)	Drivers holding a valid amateur radio operator license
8		issued by the Federal Communications Commission and

15	"Fle	et vehicle" means any vehicle validly registered

17	"Mob	ile electronic device" means any handheld or other
18	portable	electronic equipment capable of providing wireless or
19	data comm	unication between two or more persons or of providing
20	amusement	, including but not limited to a cellular phone, text
21	messaging	device, paging device, personal digital assistant,

laptop computer, video game, or digital photographic device, but

1	does not include any addro equipment of any equipment installed		
2	in a motor vehicle for the purpose of providing navigation,		
3	emergency assistance to the operator of the motor vehicle, or		
4	video entertainment to the passengers in the rear seats of the		
5	motor vehicle.		
6	"Operate" a motor vehicle means the same as is defined in		
7	section 291E-1.		
8	"Use" or "using" means holding a mobile electronic device		
9	while operating a motor vehicle.		
10	(f) Every person who violates this section shall be		
1	subject to [the following penalties:		
12	(1) For a first violation, or any violation not preceded		
13	within one year by a prior violation of this section,		
L4	a fine of not less than \$100 and not more than \$200;		
15	(2) For a violation that occurs within one year of a prior		
16	violation of this section, a fine of not less than		
17	\$200 and not more than \$300; and		
18	(3) For a violation that occurs within two years of two		
19	prior violations of this section, and for the fourth		
20	and each subsequent violation of this section,		
21	regardless of when committed, a fine of not less than		

- 1 \$300 and not more than \$500.] a fine of not less than
- **2** \$250.
- 3 If a person violates this section while operating a motor
- 4 vehicle in a school zone or construction area, as defined in
- 5 section 291C-104, the fines imposed pursuant to this subsection
- 6 shall be doubled. All fines imposed and collected for
- 7 violations pursuant to this section shall be deposited into the
- 8 state highway fund.
- 9 [(g) Any violation as provided in subsections (a) and (c)
- 10 shall not be deemed to be a traffic infraction as defined in
- 11 section 291D-2.
- 12 (h) (g) This section shall supersede any county ordinance
- 13 regulating the use or utilization of mobile electronic devices
- 14 while operating a motor vehicle."
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 17 begun before its effective date.
- 18 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Report Title:

Highway Safety; Use of Mobile Electronic Devices

Description:

Specifies that operating a motor vehicle in the State while using a mobile device is a traffic infraction. Specifies that the penalty for such an infraction shall be a fine of not less than \$250 and that collected fines shall be deposited in the state highway fund. (HB1509 HD1)

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
