BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 342G-113, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending subsections (b) and (c) to read as follows:
3	"(b)	Subsection (a) shall not apply to any dealer:
4	[-(1)	Who is located in a high density population area as
5		defined by the director in rules, and within two miles
6		of a certified redemption center that is operated
7		independently of a dealer;
8	(1)	Who is a small business as defined in section 211D-1;
9	(2)	Who is located in a rural area as defined by rule;
10	(3)	Who subcontracts with a certified redemption center to
11	·	be operated on the dealer's premises;
12	(4)	Whose sales of deposit beverage containers are only
13		via vending machines;
14	(5)	Whose place of business is less than five thousand
15		square feet of interior space;
16	(6)	Who can demonstrate physical or financial hardship, or
17		both, based on specific criteria established by rule;
18		or

1	(7) Who meets other criteria established by the director.		
2	[Notwithstanding paragraphs (1) and (2), the director may allow		
3	the placement of redemption centers at greater than prescribed		
4	distances-to-accommodate geographical features while ensuring		
5	adequate-consumer convenience.]		
6	(c) [Regardless of the square footage of a dealer's place		
7	of business, dealers Dealers who are not redemption centers		
8	shall post a clear and conspicuous sign at the primary public		
9	entrance of the dealer's place of business that specifies the		
10	name, address, and hours of operation of the two closest		
11	redemption center locations."		
12	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed		
13	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.		
14	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2015.
