## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. (a) The president of the University of Hawaii
2	shall con	vene a task force to examine the feasibility of
3	establish	ing a pay forward, pay back program at the University
4	of Hawaii	to replace or augment the current system of charging
5	students	tuition and fees for enrollment.
6	(b)	The task force shall comprise:
7	(1)	The president of the University of Hawaii, who shall
8		serve as the chairperson;
9	(2)	The director of labor and industrial relations;
10	(3)	The project manager of the economic research
11		organization at the University of Hawaii;
12	(4)	The chairperson of the board of education;
13	(5)	The director of finance;
14	(6)	The director of taxation; and
15	(7)	Any other person whom the president of the University
16		of Hawaii deems advisable for inclusion on the task
<b>17</b>		force.

- 1 (c) The task force shall consider whether the
- 2 implementation of a pay forward, pay back program at the
- 3 University of Hawaii would:
- 4 (1) Provide more students the opportunity to pursue post-
- 5 secondary education; and
- 6 (2) Significantly contribute to work force development
- 7 within the State.
- 8 (d) For purposes of this section, "pay forward, pay back"
- 9 means a system in which Hawaii residents enrolled at the
- 10 University of Hawaii pay no tuition or fees and sign binding
- 11 contracts to pay the State or the university a percentage of the
- 12 student's adjusted annual gross income, upon graduation from any
- 13 university system campus, for a period of years.
- 14 SECTION 2. The task force shall submit a written report of
- 15 its findings and recommendations, including any proposed pilot
- 16 program details and any proposed legislation, to the legislature
- 17 no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular
- 18 session of 2015.
- 19 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 20 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 21 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for the
- 22 task force established pursuant to this Act to examine the

- 1 feasibility of establishing a pay forward, pay back program at
- 2 the University of Hawaii.
- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
- 4 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
