A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FOSTER CARE SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of human services has not raised the monthly board rate for foster 2 care services since 1990. The legislature further finds that 3 4 the current monthly board rate of \$529 for all children regardless of age is insufficient due to increased costs for 5 6 food, housing, utilities, clothing, and other necessities. 7 The purpose of this Act is to increase the monthly board rate for foster care services for children. 8 SECTION 2. The department of human services shall increase 9 the rate of the monthly board payment made by the department 10 directly to foster boarding home parents, group homes, and child 11 12 caring institutions under sections 17-1617-3 and 17-1617-4,

- 14 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ 15
- 16 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for
- the purposes of this Act. 17

- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 1
- human services for the purposes of this Act. 2
- SECTION 4. The department of human services shall submit a 3
- report to the legislature, no later than twenty days prior to 4
- 5 the convening of the 2015 regular session, on the status and
- 6 costs of implementing this Act, anticipated future costs, and
- 7 number of foster children affected.

8 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
