A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TUITION ASSISTANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 121-45, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) The adjutant general, subject to the availability of
4	funds, may award tuition assistance to qualified enlisted
5	persons, warrant officers, and [company grade] officers [(0 1
6	through 0-3) grades 0-1 through 0-5 in the Hawaii national
7	guard who are:
8	(1) Residents of the State, as defined by the board of
9	regents pursuant to section [+]304A-402[+]; and
10	(2) [Undergraduate students] <u>Students</u> working toward a
11	degree on any campus of the University of Hawaii $[-]$;
12	provided that students working toward an associate or
13	undergraduate degree shall receive priority consideration for
14	the awarding of available funding for tuition assistance;
15	provided further that qualified enlisted persons and warrant
16	officers shall receive priority consideration for the awarding
17	of available funding for tuition assistance."
