

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO UNLICENSED CONTRACTOR FRAUD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 708-8302, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (2) to read as follows:
3	"(2) For purposes of this section[, "deception,"]:
4	(a) "Deception", as defined in section 708-800, includes
5	deception as to the person's status as a licensed
. 6	contractor or as to permits required to engage in the
7	activity[-]; and
8	(b) "Intent to deprive" may be formed before or after the
9	person obtains or exerts control over the property of
10	another."
11	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
12	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
13	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
