## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 There is appropriated out of the general SECTION 1. 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$344,015 or so much 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for a 4 grant-in-aid to the department of the prosecuting attorney of 5 the city and county of Honolulu for the career criminal 6 prosecution unit, including the hiring of necessary staff. 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$183,651 or so much 9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for a 10 grant-in-aid to the department of the prosecuting attorney of 11 the city and county of Honolulu for the victim witness 12 assistance program, including the hiring of necessary staff. 13 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$50,799 or so much 15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for a

grant-in-aid to the department of the prosecuting attorney of

- 1 the city and county of Honolulu for prosecution in veterans
- 2 court, including the hiring of necessary staff.
- 3 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$107,788.22 or so
- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for a
- 6 grant-in-aid to the department of the prosecuting attorney of
- 7 the city and county of Honolulu for prosecution in drug court,
- 8 including the hiring of necessary staff.
- 9 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$337,244 or so much
- 11 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for a
- 12 grant-in-aid to the department of the prosecuting attorney of
- 13 the city and county of Honolulu for the Hawaii's opportunity
- 14 probation with enforcement program, including the hiring of
- 15 necessary staff.
- 16 SECTION 6. The sums appropriated in sections 1, 2, 3, 4,
- 17 and 5 of this Act shall be expended by the department of the
- 18 prosecuting attorney of the city and county of Honolulu for the
- 19 purposes of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
