A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHER EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to article X, section 6, of the Hawaii
 State Constitution, the legislature identifies this Act as a law
 of statewide concern.

SECTION 2. (a) There shall be established at the Daniel
K. Inouye college of pharmacy at the University of Hawaii at
Hilo a five-year pilot program under which the college of
pharmacy shall be financially and managerially autonomous. The
pilot program shall commence on July 1, 2014, and terminate on
June 30, 2019.

10 (b) The college of pharmacy shall be financially supported 11 entirely by the special fund established under section 3, into 12 which shall be deposited all revenues generated by the college 13 of pharmacy.

14 (c) The University of Hawaii system may, but shall not be 15 required to, subsidize or provide any financial assistance to 16 the college of pharmacy.

17 (d) The college of pharmacy shall not be subject to any

University of Hawaii system upon its programs, departments, and
 schools.

3 SECTION 3. (a) There is established the University of
4 Hawaii at Hilo college of pharmacy special fund, which shall be
5 administered by the University of Hawaii at Hilo.

6 (b) Revenues of the special fund shall consist of all the
7 revenues of the college of pharmacy, including revenues and any
8 interest accrued from tuition, grants, fees, and donations.

9 (c) The special fund may be used for the following10 purposes:

- 11 (1) Reimbursement of all costs associated with the 12 construction, maintenance, and operation of the 13 college of pharmacy;
- 14 (2) Procurement of loans from a financial institution to
 15 construct, maintain, and operate the college of
 16 pharmacy; and
- 17 (3) Payment of any debt service on any loans made by a
 18 financial institution to the college of pharmacy to
 19 construct, maintain, or operate the college of
 20 pharmacy.

21 (d) The special fund shall be exempt from the central22 service expenses deducted pursuant to section 36-27, Hawaii



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1	Revised Statutes, or the pro rata share of departmental
2	administrative expenses charged pursuant to section 36-30,
3	Hawaii Revised Statutes.
4	(e) The special fund shall be subject to independent
5	audits upon the request of the legislature.
6	(f) On January 1, 2015, and January 1 of each of the four
7	years thereafter, the University of Hawaii at Hilo shall report
8	to the legislature on the moneys in the special fund, including
9	deposits, expenditures, and other transactions. The reports
10	shall explain in detail all expenditures from the special fund.
11	SECTION 4. The college of pharmacy at the University of
12	Hawaii at Hilo shall submit an annual financial and management
13	report to the board of regents of the University of Hawaii, the
14	governor, and the legislature not less than twenty days prior to
15	the convening of each regular session of the legislature,
16	commencing with the regular session of 2015 and ending with the
17	regular session of 2019.
18	SECTION 5. Commencing not later than July 1, 2018, the
19	University of Hawaii system shall perform a program evaluation
20	to consider whether the college of pharmacy should be continued.
21	The main criteria of the evaluation shall be the ability of the
22	college of pharmacy to fiscally sustain its operations during
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1	the five-year pilot program. If the University of Hawaii system
2	finds as a result of its program evaluation that the college of
3	pharmacy is not fiscally sustainable, then the University of
4	Hawaii system shall report its findings to the legislature no
5	later than twenty days prior to the convening of the 2019
6	regular session and may initiate proceedings to terminate the
7	pilot program as scheduled on June 30, 2019.
8	SECTION 6. In terminating the pilot program, the
. 9	University of Hawaii system shall:
10	(1) Cause all rights to and obligations for the capital
11	improvement projects undertaken by the college of
12	pharmacy pursuant to section 3(c) to be transferred
13	from the college of pharmacy to the University of
14	Hawaii system; and
15	(2) Follow established institutional and national
16	protocols to discontinue admissions to the college of
17	pharmacy and enable students who are enrolled in the
18	college of pharmacy to complete their academic
19	programs.
20	SECTION 7. There is appropriated out of the University of
21	Hawaii at Hilo college of pharmacy special fund the sum of

3	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Daniel K.
4	Inouye college of pharmacy at the University of Hawaii at Hilo
5	for the purposes of this Act.
6	SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
