#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTIO	N 1. The legislature finds that the manner by which	
2	summons are served within this State for civil actions should be		
3	consistent with other provisions of the Hawaii Revised Statutes.		
4	The purpose of this Act is to specify the manner by which		
5	summons are served for civil actions within this State.		
6	SECTION 2. Chapter 634, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
7	amended by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately		
8	designated and to read as follows:		
9	"§634 Manner of service within the State. When service		
10	of summons is required by law, court rule, or court order,		
11	service on the defendant within the State shall be:		
12	<u>(1)</u> By	y personal delivery by a person authorized to serve	
13	<u>p:</u>	rocess; or	
14	<u>(2)</u> I	f a reasonable attempt at personal delivery has not	
15	be	een successful, then by certified, registered, or	
16	<u>e:</u>	xpress mail sent to the addressee only, as ordered by	
17	<u>t</u> ]	he court.

2	shall be made in the manner prescribed by law, court rule, or
3	court order. If service is made pursuant to paragraph (2), a
4	return receipt or other proof of service provided by the postal
5	service shall be filed showing delivery to the addressee within
6	the State."
7	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
8	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
