

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
and to read as follows:
"§291C- Commercial motor vehicles; drive on right side
of roadway; exceptions. (a) Upon any roadway having three or
more clearly marked lanes for traffic in one direction, the
operator of a commercial motor vehicle shall use the traffic
lane that is as near to the right side of the roadway as
practicable.
(b) When overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding
in the same direction, the operator of a commercial motor
vehicle shall use the lane to the immediate left of the right-
hand lane.
(c) For the purposes of this section, "commercial motor
vehicle" has the same meaning as defined under section 286-2.
(d) This section shall not apply to an operator of a

Highways; Commercial Motor Vehicles; Right-Hand Lane; Use

Description:

Requires, when a highway has three or more lanes moving in the same direction, the operator of a commercial motor vehicle to drive in the right most lane. Provides certain exceptions.
