A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the transportation
- 2 of fireworks to, from, and within the State of Hawaii requires
- 3 the use of multiple modes or methods of transport that include
- 4 interstate maritime transportation, intrastate maritime
- 5 transportation, and intrastate trucking. The legislature also
- 6 finds that it is in the best interest of the community and the
- 7 State's first responders that the importation of fireworks
- 8 shipments be thoroughly accounted for and reported.
- 9 The legislature acknowledges that the current statute
- 10 provides requirements for licensed individuals or entities in
- 11 accordance with section 132D-8.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 12 However, to ensure more comprehensive tracking of all shipments
- 13 of fireworks imported into the State, additional notification
- 14 requirements affecting shippers are necessary. Further, the
- 15 legislature finds that shipments of fireworks imported into the
- 16 State of Hawaii may consist of multiple orders or lots that may
- 17 require redistribution, and these activities are not clearly
- 18 defined or recognized in the current statute.



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1 The purpose of this Act to is to: 2 (1)Delineate the notification responsibilities of 3 shippers; 4 Define the activity of redistribution; and (2) 5 (3) Clarify the labeling size of display fireworks, 6 articles pyrotechnic, and aerial devices. 7 SECTION 2. Chapter 132D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 8 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 9 and to read as follows: 10 "§132D-Notification requirements; shippers. (a) Any 11 shipper that receives fireworks that are imported into the State or between counties shall notify the appropriate fire chief in 12 13 writing as to whether the shipment will be distributed from: 14 (1) Pier to pier; 15 (2) Pier to warehouse or storage facility; or 16 (3) Pier to redistribution." 17 SECTION 3. Section 132D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 18 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted 19 and to read as follows: 20 ""Redistribution" means the performing or conducting of 21 temporary or short-term activities related to the unpacking, 22 segregating, and repacking of a consolidated shipment of

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1	fireworks or articles pyrotechnic for the purpose of		
2	transporting or delivering to one or more of the three types of		
3	licensee sites as regulated in section 132D-8.6."		
4	SECTION 4. Section 132D-16.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
5	amended b	y amending subsection (b) to read as follows:	
6	" (b)	Each shell, mine, comet, and multiple tube device,	
7	such as f	inale or barrage boxes, roman candle batteries, or	
8	cakes, sh	all bear a permanent label listing the licensee's name	
9	address,	and contact information to include <u>a</u> telephone number	
10	or electronic mail address. The label shall also list the name		
11	and business address of the manufacturer. The label shall be		
12	approved by the state fire council and conform to the following		
13	standards:		
14	(1)	Numerals and letters of the printed matter shall be	
15		not less than one-eighth of an inch high;	
16	(2)	Required statements shall be printed in a color that	
17		contrasts sharply with the background and shall be	
18		printed within a borderline; and	
19	(3)	The label shall measure at least nine square [inches	
20	·	by nine] inches; provided that if the size of the	
21		shell, mine, comet, or multiple tube device is too	
22		small to correctly display a label of this size, the	



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1	label may be reduced to a size no smaller than
2	necessary to properly display the information
3	described in this section."
4	SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
6	SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
