

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRIVACY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 711, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:	
4	"§711- Disorderly conduct by invasion of privacy. (1)	
5	A person	commits the offense of disorderly conduct by invasion
6	of privacy, with intent to cause serious emotional distress, or	
7	recklessly creating a risk thereof, if:	
8	<u>(a)</u>	The person photographs or records by any means the
9	٠.	image of the intimate body part or parts of another
10		identifiable person under circumstances where the
11		parties agree or understand that the image shall
12		remain private;
13	<u>(b)</u>	The person subsequently distributes the image taken
14		with the intent to cause serious emotional distress,
15		or recklessly creating a risk thereof; and
16	<u>(c)</u>	The person depicted in the image suffers serious
17		emotional distress.
18	(2)	For purposes of this section:



1	"Distribute" means to post an image of another identifiable			
2	person's intimate body part on a website or in any other public			
3	or private forum, or to send, transfer, or give an image of			
4	another identifiable person's intimate body part, whether in			
5	hard copy or electronic form, to a third party.			
6	"Intimate body part" means any portion of the genitals, and			
7	in the case of a female, also includes any portion of the			
8	breasts below the top of the areola, that is either uncovered or			
9	visible through less than fully opaque clothing.			
0	(3) Disorderly conduct by invasion of privacy is a			
1	misdemeanor."
