A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO MANAGE ALBIZIA TREES ON THE ISLAND OF HAWATT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that albizia trees are an
- 2 invasive species that present an increasingly costly threat to
- 3 the economy, critical infrastructure, and public safety on the
- 4 island of Hawaii. These trees proliferate in many areas of the
- 5 State, but are an especially worrisome hazard in East Hawaii,
- 6 where they grow in areas critical to public safety, including
- 7 along tsunami evacuation routes and near the region's only
- 8 critical care hospital. Further, albizia trees are more likely
- 9 than many species of comparable size to fall or break in windy
- 10 or rainy conditions. In a natural disaster situation, such as a
- 11 tsunami or hurricane, fallen albizia trees could put lives at
- 12 risk by blocking evacuation routes or impeding access to
- 13 emergency care facilities. The legislature finds that the
- 14 location and density of albizia trees in East Hawaii, along with
- 15 their propensity to fall or break in inclement conditions make
- 16 albizia trees a significant threat to the public safety.

H.B. NO. H.D. 1

- 1 Through a recent demonstration program, the Big Island
- 2 invasive species committee demonstrated the effectiveness and
- 3 necessity of a coordinated approach to controlling the growth
- 4 and spread of albizia trees. It is the intent of the
- 5 legislature that the department of land and natural resources
- 6 continue these efforts and, in partnership with the state
- 7 department of defense, act to secure additional resources for
- 8 albizia tree removal to mitigate the public safety hazard caused
- 9 by the presence of these trees along tsunami evacuation routes
- 10 on Hawaii island.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 12 department of land and natural resources for the control of
- 13 albizia trees along tsunami evacuation routes on the island of
- 14 Hawaii.
- 15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for
- 18 the immediate, coordinated management of albizia trees that
- 19 threaten access to and safe passage along tsunami evacuation
- 20 routes on the island of Hawaii.
- 21 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 22 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.

- 1 SECTION 3. The department of land and natural resources
- 2 and the Hawaii department of defense shall work in partnership
- 3 to secure additional funding and resources for albizia tree
- 4 removal to mitigate the public safety hazard caused by the
- 5 presence of these trees along tsunami evacuation routes on
- 6 Hawaii island in accordance with the purposes of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
