
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS PERMIT FEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the fireworks
2 display permit fee for aerial devices, display fireworks, or
3 articles pyrotechnic has remained the same since 2006, but the
4 cost to process, review, and approve the application for this
5 permit that authorizes licensed pyrotechnicians to conduct
6 outdoor aerial fireworks and indoor fireworks for theatrical
7 purposes has increased.

8 The purpose of this Act is to increase the fireworks
9 display permit fee from \$110 to \$300.

10 SECTION 2. Section 132D-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
11 amended to read as follows:

12 "§132D-10 Permits. A permit shall be required for the
13 purchase and use of:

14 (1) Any consumer fireworks commonly known as firecrackers
15 upon payment of a fee of \$25;

16 (2) Any aerial devices, display fireworks, or articles
17 pyrotechnic for the purposes of section 132D-16 upon
18 payment of a fee of [~~\$110~~] \$300; and



1 (3) Any consumer fireworks for the purposes of section
2 132D-5 or for cultural uses that occur at any time
3 other than during the periods prescribed in section
4 132D-3(1) upon a payment of a fee of \$25."

5 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
