### A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE HAWAII CONSTITUTION TO LIMIT THE TERMS OF LEGISLATORS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
- 2 amendment to article III, section 4, of the Constitution of the
- 3 State of Hawaii to limit the terms of members of the legislature
- 4 to five consecutive terms for a seat in the house of
- 5 representatives and to three consecutive terms for a seat of the
- 6 senate, as provided by law.
- 7 SECTION 2. Article III, section 4, of the Constitution of
- 8 the State of Hawaii is amended to read as follows:
- 9 "ELECTION OF MEMBERS; TERM
- 10 Section 4. Each member of the legislature shall be elected
- 11 at an election. If more than one candidate has been nominated
- 12 for election to a seat in the legislature, the member occupying
- 13 that seat shall be elected at a general election. If a
- 14 candidate nominated for a seat at a primary election is
- 15 unopposed for that seat at the general election, the candidate
- 16 shall be deemed elected at the primary election. The term of
- 17 office of a member of the house of representatives shall be two

- 1 years and the term of office of a member of the senate shall be
- 2 four years. The term of a member of the legislature shall begin
- 3 on the day of the general election at which elected or if
- 4 elected at a primary election, on the day of the general
- 5 election immediately following the primary election at which
- 6 elected. For a member of the house of representatives, the term
- 7 shall end on the day of the general election immediately
- 8 following the day the member's term commences. No person shall
- 9 be elected to a seat in the house of representatives for more
- 10 than five consecutive terms, as provided by law. For a member
- 11 of the senate, the term shall end on the day of the second
- 12 general election immediately following the day the member's term
- 13 commences. No person shall be elected to a seat in the senate
- 14 for more than three consecutive terms, as provided by law."
- 15 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
- 16 be as follows:
- "Shall the members of the legislature be subject to term
- 18 limits of five consecutive terms (ten years) for a seat in
- the house of representatives and of three consecutive terms
- 20 (twelve years) for a seat in the senate, as provided by
- 21 law?"
- 22 SECTION 4. New constitutional material is underscored.
