Contributions received 3 4 through the mail during a regular session or special session may 5 be accepted if the contribution is postmarked prior to the 6 commencement of the regular session or the special session. 7 $[\frac{(c)}{(c)}]$ (d) As used in this section, "fundraiser" means any function held for the benefit of a candidate, candidate 8 9 committee, or noncandidate committee that is intended or 10 designed, directly or indirectly, to raise contributions [for 11 which the price or suggested-contribution for attending the 12 . function is more than \$25 per person]."
