A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TAXATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. (a) The department of taxation shall develop a plan, including proposed legislation, to implement a flat income tax rate of per cent of taxable income that shall be ready for implementation no later than the 2017 taxable year.
- for implementation no later than the 2017 taxable year.

 (b) The flat tax shall replace the income tax schedule in section 235-51, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and shall dedicate per cent of the income tax revenues to the State's medicaid program under the department of human services. The flat tax rate shall not exceed three per cent of an individual's taxable income.
- 11 (c) The department of taxation may work with the
 12 department of budget and finance, the department of human
 13 services, the legislature, and other departments as necessary,
 14 to develop the plan and proposed legislation.
- (d) The plan and proposed legislation may include:
- 16 (1) Repealing tax deductions, exemptions, and credits, as
 17 needed to implement the flat tax;
