## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of transportation shall
- 2 conduct a traffic study of the H-1 freeway, particularly from
- 3 the H-1/H-2 merge to exit number 10 between the times of 5:30
- 4 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. for eastbound traffic and from 3:30 p.m. to
- 5 6:30 p.m. for westbound traffic on weekdays for the purpose of
- 6 developing alternative traffic solutions and assessing the
- 7 impact of future population growth.
- 8 (b) The department of transportation shall submit a report
- 9 of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 10 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days before
- 11 the convening of the regular session of 2015.
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$50,000 or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for a
- 15 traffic study of the H-1 freeway for the purpose of developing
- 16 alternative traffic solutions and assessing the impact of future
- 17 population growth.

- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 1
- transportation for the purposes of this Act. 2
- SECTION 3. The unexpended or unencumbered balance as of 3
- June 30, 2015, of any appropriation made by this Act shall lapse
- into the general fund. 5

SECTION 4 This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014. 6
