A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The University of Hawaii acquired lands for the			
2	University of Hawaii at West Oahu through a land exchange			
3	approved in Act 294, Session Laws of Hawaii 1996. Subsequent			
4	the University of Hawaii at West Oahu campus has grown and			
5	continues to grow according to the university's long-range			
6	development plans. However, the legislature finds that there			
7	remains significant acreage that could be used for revenue-			
8	generating purposes for the support of the University of Hawaii			
9	at West Oahu. The university is supported with public funds and			
10	as such, it is the legislature's responsibility to ensure that			
11	the university is fiscally sustainable. Consequently, the			
12	legislature finds and declares that the disposition of land with			
13	the potential for revenue generation is an issue of statewide			
14	concern and therefore under the legislature's purview pursuant			
15	to article x, section 6 of the Hawaii State Constitution.			
16	The purpose of this Act is to:			

(1) Prohibit the sale or gift of the University of Hawaii

- 6 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon approval and
- 7 shall be repealed on June 30, 2016; provided that section
- 8 304A-2166(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted in the
- 9 form in which it read on the day prior to the effective date of
- 10 this Act.
