

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SIDEWALKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 Section 711-1105, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending subsections (1) and (2) to read as follows: 3 "(1) A person commits the offense of obstructing if, 4 having no legal privilege to do so, the person knowingly or 5 recklessly obstructs any highway or public passage, including any sidewalk, whether alone or with others. 6 (2) A person in a gathering commits the offense of 7 8 obstructing if the person refuses to obey a reasonable request
- 10 (a) To prevent obstruction of a highway or other public passage [7], including any sidewalk; or

or order by a law enforcement officer to move:

- (b) To maintain public safety by dispersing those gathered
 in dangerous proximity to a public hazard."
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 15 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 16 begun before its effective date.
- 17 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
