# H.B. NO. 1875

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LANDFILLS.

-	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:
1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish a host
2	municipality benefit fee to be paid by operators of privately
3	owned or operated recovery facilities or landfills to offset the
4	impact of the facilities.
5	SECTION 2. Chapter 342G, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
6	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
7	and to read as follows:
8	"§342G- Host municipality benefit fee. Each operator of
9	a privately owned or operated resource recovery landfill,
10	excluding transfer stations, shall be subject to a host
11	municipality benefit fee for any health or safety violation
12	pursuant to chapter 342H. The fee shall be \$250 per violation;
13	provided that all of the fees collected shall be deposited into
14	a separate account of the general fund for distribution by the
15	department of education in equal amounts to every high school
16	within a five-mile radius of the landfill that incurred the fee.
17	If there is no high school within a five-mile radius of the

landfill that incurred the fee, the fee collected shall be 1 deposited into the environmental response revolving fund." 2 SECTION 3. Section 342H-10.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 3 amended to read as follows: 4 "§342H-10.5 Disposition of collected fines and penalties. 5 Except as otherwise provided in this section [-7] and section 6 342H- , fees, fines, and penalties collected under sections 7 342H-9 [and], 342H-10, and 342H- shall be deposited into the 8 environmental response revolving fund established by section 9 128D-2. Where a county individually, or the State and a county 10 jointly, initiates and conducts an investigation resulting in 11 the imposition and collection of a fine or penalty, pursuant to 12 section 342H-30(c), the fine or penalty shall be distributed as 13 follows: 14 One half to the department of the county whose 15 (1)officers or employees initiated and conducted the 16 investigation; and 17 (2) One half to the environmental response revolving fund 18 established in section 128D-2." 19 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 21
