

- 1 (1) Move freely in public spaces, including on public
2 sidewalks, in public parks, on public transportation,
3 and in public buildings without harassment or
4 intimidation from law enforcement officials, in the
5 same manner as other persons;
- 6 (2) Have equal opportunities for employment;
- 7 (3) Receive emergency medical care;
- 8 (4) Register to vote and to vote;
- 9 (5) Have personal information protected;
- 10 (6) Have a reasonable expectation of privacy in one's
11 personal property; and
- 12 (7) Receive equal treatment by state and county agencies.
- 13 (c) Each county may post in a usual location for county
14 notices a notice entitled "A HOMELESS PERSON'S BILL OF RIGHTS"
15 that contains the text set forth in subsection (b)."
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
