

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LABOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§387-2 Minimum wages. Except as provided in section 4 387-9 and this section, every employer shall pay to each 5 employee employed by the employer, wages at the rate of not less 6 than: 7 \$6.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2003; (1)8 (2)\$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2006; [and] \$7.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2007[-]; 9 (3) \$7.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2015; 10 (4)11 (5) \$8.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2016; 12 (6) \$8.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2017; and 13 \$9.00 per hour beginning January 1, 2018. (7) 14 The hourly wage of a tipped employee may be deemed to be 15 increased on account of tips if the employee is paid not less 16 than 25 cents below the applicable minimum wage by the 17 employee's employer and the combined amount the employee

- 1 receives from the employee's employer and in tips is at least 50
- 2 cents more than the applicable minimum wage."
- 3 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
