A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUNTING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the enhancement and
2	maintenance of sustainable public hunting opportunities for
3	subsistence and recreational purposes are of critical importance
4	to the State and its people. A coordinated resource management
5	effort involving stakeholders is needed to prevent and offset
6	the loss, destruction, or degradation of public hunting areas on
7	any island of the State and expeditiously find replacement land
8	for hunting.
9	SECTION 2. Chapter 183D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10	amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
11	designated and to read as follows:
12	"§183D- Hunting advisory commission. (a) There is
13	established within the department a hunting advisory commission,
14	which shall serve in an advisory capacity to the board. The
15	commission shall consist of twelve members to be appointed by
16	the governor in the manner provided in section 26-34. The
17	commission shall meet not less than quarterly. Membership on
18	the advisory commission shall consist of:

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1	<u>(1)</u>	Two members of the department having experience in
2		sustainable game management principles and practices,
3		to be designated by the chairperson of the board;
4	(2)	One member from the division of conservation and
5		resource enforcement;
6	<u>(3)</u>	Five members of the hunting community, of which there
7		shall be one member for each of the following
8		geographic areas: Oahu, Kauai, Maui, east Hawaii, and
9		west Hawaii;
10	(4)	Executive director of the aha moku advisory council;
11	(5)	One member who is a scientist with expertise in the
12		field of mammalogy or ornithology;
13	<u>(6)</u>	One member representing the endangered species
14		recovery committee; and
15	<u>(7)</u>	One member representing the tourism industry.
16	(b)	The commission shall select its own chairperson. The
17	members s	hall receive no compensation for their services on the
18	commission	n but shall be entitled to reimbursement for necessary
19	expenses	while attending meetings and while in the discharge of
20	their dut	ies.

1	(C)	The commission shall advise the board on proposals to
2	enhance a	nd maintain to enhance and maintain the quantity and
3	quality o	f public hunting areas.
4	(d)	The commission shall consult with the board on any
5	matter af	fecting hunting, including proposed rules. The
6	commissio	n may take testimony and acquire information as it
7	desires a	nd shall communicate its findings and recommendations
8	to the bo	ard."
9	SECT	ION 3. (a) There is established a hunting pilot
10	program o	n the island of Hawaii. The program shall be an
11	undertaki	ng of the hunting advisory commission established
12	pursuant	to section 2 of this Act. The hunting advisory
13	commissio	n shall:
14	(1)	Recommend to the department of land and natural
15		resources which public lands on the island of Hawaii
16		shall be designated as public hunting areas while
17		preserving designated watershed areas that are
18		protected in accordance with law; and
19	(2)	Implement a game management plan or hunting plan for
20		the island of Hawaii after consultation with the
21		hunting community on the island of Hawaii and the

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1	appropriate county agency naving jurisdiction over		
2	hunting and natural resource preservation.		
3	(b) The hunting advisory commission shall report to the		
4	legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of		
5	the regular session of 2015 and each session thereafter on its		
6	efforts to comply with this section and the results thereof,		
7	including a description of its activities in the year preceding		
8	the report.		
9	(c) This section shall be repealed on June 30, 2020.		
10	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general		
11	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$110,000, or so much		
12	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for the		
13	administrative expenses of the hunting advisory commission		
14	established pursuant to section 2 of this Act; provided that the		
15	funds appropriated shall be matched dollar-for-dollar by the		
16	county of Hawaii.		
17	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of		
18	land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.		
19	SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.		
20	SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
