A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LAND USE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 205, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately		
3	designated and to read as follows:		
4	"§205- Extension of time for completion of district		
5	boundary amendment. (a) If a person who has petitioned for a		
6	district boundary amendment that has been approved by the land		
7	use commission requests an extension of the time period to		
8	comply with any requirement, term, or condition imposed by the		
9	commission as part of the approval of the amendment, the		
10	commission shall extend the date or time by which the		
11	requirement, term, or condition must be completed for at least		
12	two years; provided that:		
13	(1) The appropriate officer or agency identified under		
14	section 205-12 of the county in which the land is		
15	situated determines that:		
16	(A) The petitioner has substantially commenced		
17	development of the property in accordance with		

1		all commission-imposed requirements, terms, and	
2		conditions of the district boundary amendment; or	
3	<u>(B)</u>	Other good cause exists to extend the date or	
4		time for completion of all commission-imposed	
5		requirements, terms, and conditions of the	
6		district boundary amendment; and	
7	<u>(2)</u> The	requirements, terms, and conditions of the	
8	ext	ension of date or time shall not be more	
9	res	trictive than those contained in the commission	
10	dec	ision approving the district boundary amendment on	
11	whi	ch the extension is based.	
12	(b) For	the purposes of subsection (a)(1), a determination	
13	of whether a petitioner has substantially commenced development		
14	of the property in accordance with commission-imposed		
15	requirements, terms, or conditions shall be at the sole		
16	discretion of the appropriate officer or agency identified under		
17	section 205-12 of the county in which the land is situated."		
18	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.		
19	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.

Land Use Commission; Boundary Amendment; Time Period Extension

Description:

Requires the land use commission, upon request, to extend the time period for which a boundary amendment is effective for at least two years if the appropriate county officer or agency determines that the petitioner has substantially commenced development or if other good cause exists. Effective July 1, 2030. (HB193 HD1)
