BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 551A-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows: 3 The public quardian shall serve as guardian, limited "(a) quardian, testamentary quardian, or temporary quardian of an 4 5 incapacitated person when so appointed by the family court or by the circuit court under chapter 560. [The] Notwithstanding 6 section 560:5-304, the public guardian may not file a petition 7 for the public guardian's own appointment. Petitions for public 8 quardianship may [also] be filed by any person, agency, or 9 10 facility responsible for the support or care of individuals who: Are not able to understand or adequately participate 11 (1) in decisions concerning their care; and 12 Have no relatives or friends willing and able to act 13 (2) 14 as a guardian. The public guardian shall have the same powers and 15 (b) duties as a private quardian.
