### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 551A-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:		
3	"(a) The public guardian shall serve as guardian, limited		
4	guardian, testamentary guardian, or temporary guardian of an		
5	incapacitated person when so appointed by the family court or by		
6	the circuit court under chapter 560. [ <del>The</del> ] <u>Notwithstanding</u>		
7	section 560:5-304, the public guardian may not file a petition		
8	for the public guardian's own appointment. Petitions for public		
9	guardianship may [ <del>also</del> ] be filed by any person, agency, or		
10	facility responsible for the support or care of individuals who:		
11	(1) Are not able to understand or adequately participate		
12	in decisions concerning their care; and		
13	(2) Have no relatives or friends willing and able to act		
14	as a guardian.		
15	(b) The public guardian shall have the same powers and		
16	duties as a private guardian. <u>In addition, if there is no</u>		
17	conservatorship in effect for a ward, the court may authorize
