### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CYBERSECURITY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that implementing
- 2 effective cybersecurity measures is a challenge faced by all
- 3 states. The legislature also finds that coordinating the
- 4 resources of the department of defense, the University of
- 5 Hawaii, and the office of information technology will help to
- 6 create educational programs to improve cybersecurity in the
- 7 State and develop responses to cyber-attacks.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to establish the Hawaii
- 9 cybersecurity, economic, education, and infrastructure security
- 10 council to recommend improvements to the State's cybersecurity
- 11 and to develop methods for securing federal moneys to fund other
- 12 cybersecurity improvements.
- 13 SECTION 2. (a) There is established the Hawaii
- 14 cybersecurity, economic, education, and infrastructure security
- 15 council within the office of information technology for
- 16 administrative purposes.
