### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IN VITRO FERTILIZATION INSURANCE COVERAGE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 431:10A-116.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, 2 is amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 All individual and group accident and health or 4 sickness insurance policies which provide pregnancy-related 5 benefits shall include in addition to any other benefits for 6 treating infertility, a one-time only benefit for all outpatient 7 expenses arising from in vitro fertilization procedures 8 performed on the insured or the insured's dependent spouse; 9 provided that: 10 (1)Benefits under this section shall be provided to the 11 same extent as the benefits provided for other 12 pregnancy-related benefits; 13 (2) The patient is the insured or covered dependent of the 14 insured; 15 (3) The patient's oocytes are fertilized with the 16 patient's spouse's sperm; (4) 17 The:
