

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TUITION ASSISTANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 121-45, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) The adjutant general, subject to the availability of
4	funds, may award tuition assistance to qualified enlisted
5	persons, warrant officers, and [company grade] officers [(0-1
6	through 0-3) grade 0-1 through 0-5 in the Hawaii national guard
7	who are:
8	(1) Residents of the State, as defined by the board of
9	regents pursuant to section [+]304A-402[+]; and
10	(2) [Undergraduate students] Students working toward a
11	degree on any campus of [the University of Hawaii.]
12	any accredited post-secondary educational institution
13	authorized by the State pursuant to chapter 305J;
14	provided that students working toward an associate or
15	undergraduate degree shall receive priority consideration for
16	the awarding of available funding for tuition assistance;
17	provided further that qualified enlisted persons and warrant

- 1 officers shall receive priority consideration for the awarding
- 2 of available funding for tuition assistance."
- 3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,000,000 or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for
- 6 awarding tuition assistance to qualified enlisted persons,
- 7 warrant officers, and officers grade 0-1 through 0-5 in the
- 8 Hawaii National Guard.
- 9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 10 defense for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
