### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE STATEMENTS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 84-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows: "(d) 3 The financial disclosure statements of the following 4 persons shall be public records and available for inspection and 5 duplication: 6 (1)The governor, the lieutenant governor, the members of the legislature, candidates for and delegates to the 7 constitutional convention, the trustees of the office 9 of Hawaiian affairs, and candidates for state elective 10 offices: The directors of the state departments and their 11 (2) 12 deputies, regardless of the titles by which the 13 foregoing persons are designated; provided that with 14 respect to the department of the attorney general, the 15 foregoing shall apply only to the attorney general and 16 the first deputy attorney general;
