A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL PRODUCT LABELING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 486, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to part V to be appropriately 3 designated and to read as follows: 4 "§486- Agricultural product branding and country or 5 region of origin labeling. (a) All honey, macadamia nuts, 6 coffee, tea, vanilla, and any other plant or animal product 7 grown, packaged, or sold in Hawai'i for which any information or 8 name indicating "Hawai'i", "Hawaiian", or any region of Hawai'i, 9 and where the product is less than one hundred per cent grown in 10 Hawai'i, shall after the word "Contains:" list on the front label 11 the country or region of origin and the percentage of each 12 country's or region's portion of the product in descending order 13 of percentage and in font size at least equal to one-half the 14 size of the largest font on the front label; provided that this 15 subsection shall not apply to spices unless spice is the major 16 portion of the product.

8		size at least equal to one-half the size of the
9		largest font on the front label; and
10	(2)	Any blended product that contains less than seventy-
11		five per cent of a Hawaiian product shall not use the
12		names "Hawaiʻi" or "Hawaiian" or any Hawaiian regional
13		name on the front label, except in the contents list,
14		which shall identify on the front label the countries
15		or geographic regions of origin for the entire product
16		with the percentage for each country's or region's
17		portion of the product in a font size at least equal
18		to one-half the size of the largest font on the front
19		label.
20	<u>(e)</u>	Nothing stated on the side or back labels on any
21	product s	ubject to this section shall be inconsistent with
22	statement	s appearing on the front label."



1 SECTION 2. To the extent the provisions of this section 2 are inconsistent with the labeling requirements of section 486-120.5, 486-120.6, or 486-119, Hawaii Revised Statutes, or any 3 other statutory provision, the provisions of this Act shall 4 5 control.

6 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval; provided that the Act shall not be implemented until eighteen 8 months after its effective date. 9
