### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 134-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended b	y amending subsection (g) to read as follows:	
3	" (g)	[Effective July 1, 1995, no person] No applicant	
4	shall be	issued a permit under this section for the acquisition	
5	of a pist	ol or revolver unless the [person,] applicant, at any	
6	time prio	r to the issuance of the permit, has completed:	
7	(1)	An approved hunter education course as authorized	
.8		under section 183D-28;	
9	(2)	A firearms safety or training course or class	
10		available to the general public offered by a law	
11		enforcement agency of the State or of any county;	
12	(3)	A firearms safety or training course offered to law	
13		enforcement officers, security guards, investigators,	
14		deputy sheriffs, or any division or subdivision of law	
15		enforcement or security enforcement by a state or	
16		county law enforcement agency; or	
17	(4)	A firearms training or safety course or class	
18		conducted by a state certified or National Rifle

1	Association certified firearms instructor or a
2	certified military firearms instructor that provides,
