BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 708-803, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending subsection (4) to read as follows: 3 "(4) For a conviction under this section, the sentence 4 shall be [either: 5 (a) An] an indeterminate term of imprisonment of five years[; or 7 (b) A term of probation of five years, with conditions to 8 include but not be limited to one year of 9 imprisonment]." 10 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 11 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 12 begun before its effective date. 13 Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
