- 11 (b) The department and authorized agencies shall make
- 12 reasonable efforts to identify and notify all relatives of the
- 13 child within thirty days after assuming foster custody of the
- 14 child.
- (c) Following the placement of a child with a resource
- 16 family, the department shall visit the child at the resource
- 17 family home at least once per month until:
- 18 <u>(1)</u> The child's adoption is finalized;
