A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION MANAGEMENT OFFICE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

. 1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the quality of the
2	environment is as important to the welfare of the people of
3	Hawaii as is the economy of the State. The legislature finds
4	that there is increasing demand for the collection and
5	dissemination of state environmental data to the public, to the
6	regulated and permitted community, and to the United States
7	Environmental Protection Agency. The legislature also finds
8	that the development of specialized environmental information
9	management systems can greatly assist the department of health's
10	environmental health administration to provide timely and
11	comprehensive environmental information to the public, increase
12	efficiency, and make more informed decisions to better protect
13	the environment. The legislature finds that an environmental
14	information management office needs to be established to more
15	efficiently and effectively collect and disseminate
16	environmental data. This in turn will greatly assist the
17	environmental programs to make better decisions through the

- 1 development of enhanced software programs. To maintain current
- 2 successful software systems, as well as continue to develop new
- 3 ones, the legislature finds that the environmental information
- 4 management office should be created in the department of health.
- 5 SECTION 2. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by
- 6 adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 "CHAPTER
- 9 ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION MANAGEMENT OFFICE
- 10 § -1 Definitions. As used in this chapter, unless the
- 11 context otherwise requires:
- 12 "Director" means the director of health.
- 13 "Manager" means the manager of the environmental
- 14 information management office.
- 15 "Office" means the environmental information management
- 16 office established in section -2.
- 17 § -2 Environmental information management office;
- 18 establishment. There is established an environmental
- 19 information management office to be placed in the department of
- 20 health. The office shall be headed by a single executive to be
- 21 known as the manager of environmental information management and
- 22 shall be appointed by the director. The manager may hire staff,

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1	as may be	necessary. The office shall perform duties under this
2	chapter a	nd shall serve the director in an advisory capacity on
3	all matte	rs relating to environmental information management.
4	S	-3 Duties. The office shall:
5	(1)	Promote the use of environmental information systems
6		and new management innovations such as mobile
7		applications that enable efficient and nonduplicative
8		collection and dissemination of environmental data for
9		the department environmental programs, the department,
10		the State, and the public;
11	(2)	Provide effective project management to design,
12		develop, and implement useful and relevant
13		environmental information management systems;
L4	(3)	Develop and implement environmental information
15		management policy, in accordance with policy set by
16		the office of information management and technology,
17		the department, and the United States Environmental
18		Protection Agency for environmental health programs
19		within the department;

(4) Seek partnerships and funding opportunities with

outside entities to develop and collaborate on new

environmental information management systems and to

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1		enhance current environmental information management
2		systems; and
3	(5)	Promote the federal impetus for environmental programs
4		to reduce the burden of regulatory reporting
5		processes, increase efficiencies in data reporting and
6		accessibility, and facilitate effective coordination
7		of environmental regulatory data functions."
3	SECT	TION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
