A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE USE OF TOBACCO AND E-CIGARETTES ON HAWAII HEALTH SYSTEMS CORPORATION PREMISES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the health		
2 -	facilities within the Hawaii health systems corporation are		
3	committed to providing quality health care for the people of		
4	Hawaii and are taking steps to reduce the occurrence of		
5	preventable disease. Consistent with this commitment, the		
6	corporation should prohibit the use of tobacco and other		
7	potentially dangerous substances on the campuses of its health		
8	facilities, as allowing such use would not only expose		
9	vulnerable patients, employees, and visitors to the perils of		
10	harmful substances, but would also demonstrate a shortcoming in		
11	the corporation's goal of reducing the occurrence of preventable		
12	disease.		
13	The purpose of this Act is to:		
14	(1) Protect patients, employees, and visitors in the		
15	health facilities of the Hawaii health systems		

corporation from exposure to second-hand smoke and

other potentially harmful substances;

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1	(2)	Promote positive health practices by prohibiting any	
2		person from using tobacco products or e-cigarettes on	
3		the premises of any Hawaii health systems corporation	
4		health facility; and	
5	(3)	Make tobacco-cessation programs available to public	
6		health facility employees.	
7	SECTION 2. Chapter 323F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
8	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
9	and to read as follows:		
10	" <u>§</u> 32	3F- Tobacco and e-cigarette use prohibited. (a)	
11	Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary in chapter 328J,		
12	the use of any tobacco product or e-cigarette by any person on		
13	the premises of any health facility operated by the corporation		
14	within the State is prohibited, to the extent not preempted by		
15	federal law or regulation.		
16	<u>(b)</u>	The corporation shall provide tobacco cessation	
17	programs	for public employees who are interested in	
18	participa	ting at the corporation's health facilities.	
19	<u>(c)</u>	The corporation shall be responsible for educating all	
20	health fa	cility personnel, contractors, patients, and all other	
21	visitors	to the corporation's health facilities regarding the	
22	prohibiti	ons under this section. The corporation shall	
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- 1 prominently display signs stating that "tobacco and e-cigarette
- 2 use is prohibited" at all entrances to the corporation's health
- 3 facilities and at other conspicuous locations throughout the
- 4 outdoor premises of each health facility.
- 5 (d) For the purposes of this section:
- 6 "E-cigarette" means any electronic oral device, such as one
- 7 composed of a heating element, battery, or electronic circuit,
- 8 or more than one of these, which provides a vapor of nicotine or
- 9 any other substance for inhalation. The term shall include any
- 10 such device, whether manufactured, distributed, marketed, or
- 11 sold as an e-cigarette, e-cigar, e-pipe, or under any other
- 12 product name or descriptor, but does not include any product
- 13 specifically approved by the United States Food and Drug
- 14 Administration for use in medical treatment, such as an asthma
- 15 inhaler.
- "Premises" means all indoor and outdoor areas within the
- 17 State-designated property boundary lines of each of the
- 18 corporation's health facilities and shall include all employee
- 19 and visitor parking lots.
- 20 "Tobacco or e-cigarette use" does not include mere
- 21 possession or storage of the same for use in locations outside
- 22 the premises of the corporation's health facilities.

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1 "Tobacco product" means any substance containing tobacco 2 leaf including, but not limited to, cigarettes, cigars, pipe tobacco, hookah tobacco, snuff, chewing tobacco, dipping 3 tobacco, bidis, blunts, clove cigarettes, or any other 4 5 preparations of tobacco; and any product or formulation of 6 matter containing biologically active amounts of nicotine that 7 is manufactured, sold, offered for sale, or otherwise distributed with the expectation that the product or matter will 8 9 be introduced into the human body. "Tobacco product" does not 10 include any cessation product specifically approved by the 11 United States Food and Drug Administration for the sole use of 12 treating nicotine or tobacco dependence." 13 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
