MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE HAWAII HEALTH SYSTEMS CORPORATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
- 4 SECTION 2. The purpose of this Act is to make an emergency
- 5 appropriation to provide funds for the functions of the Hawaii
- 6 health systems corporation and its regions. Without an
- 7 emergency appropriation, Hawaii health systems corporation
- 8 health care operations will be severely impacted, and the impact
- 9 will place the health care of the residents and visitors of the
- 10 State in jeopardy.
- 11 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$15,500,000, or so
- 13 much thereof as may be necessary, for fiscal year 2013-2014 for
- 14 the purpose of supporting the functions of the Hawaii health
- 15 systems corporation.
- 16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii health
- 17 systems corporation for the purposes of this Act.

regional health care system has had to borrow money from other parts of the system

to make payroll for several months.
