A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 206M, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and 3 to read as follows: 4 "PART CREATIVE FILM AND MEDIA PARK 5 \$206M− Purpose. The legislature finds that the State's production resources and educational programs, including the 6 7 ongoing development of the University of Hawaii at West Oahu and 8 the Searider productions program at Waianae high school, provide 9 a genuine opportunity to foster a film production industry that benefits the State and the community. The influx of film 10 11 companies has also reinvigorated this sector of the State's economy. If a geographic area is dedicated for a film and media 12 park to promote growth in the business of creative media and 13 film, high school graduates who studied in programs such as the 14 15 Searider productions program would have an opportunity to obtain 16 employment in their field within the State.
