### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, due to the State's
- 2 liability for individuals detained or incarcerated in state
- 3 correctional facilities, the State must maintain certain
- 4 standards in those facilities to ensure the safety of the
- 5 general public, facility staff and administration, and
- 6 incarcerated individuals. The purpose of this Act is to provide
- 7 funding for planning and site development necessary to meet
- 8 facility standards by upgrading or replacing aging correctional
- 9 facilities to address concerns such as inmate overcrowding.
- 10 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
- 11 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$9,500,000 or so much
- 12 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
- 13 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2014-2015
- 14 for the purpose of improving Hawaii's correctional facilities
- 15 through capital improvement projects for facility planning and
- 16 site development, as follows:
