3	"-(b)	In order to obtain a permit $[er]_{\underline{t}}$ a permit renewal,
4	or to be	placed on a waitlist for a permit, the owner of a
5	vessel shall provide, at the owner's own expense:	
6	(1)	A marine surveyor's inspection no more than two years
7		old, certifying that the surveyor has inspected the
8		vessel and considers it to fulfill the requirements
9		set by the department; [and]
10	(2)	Documentation that the person is the owner of the
11		vessel. The documentation shall meet requirements
12		established by the department[-]; and
13	(3)	Satisfactory proof that the person has attained the
14		age of eighteen years."
15	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that	
16	matured,	penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
17	begun before its effective date.
