## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FEDERAL FUNDS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 29-25, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:

4	fund offset. (a) [Federal impact aid,] United States
5	Department of Defense funds[7] and federal indirect overhead

9	education shall be transferred to the general fund.

Section 302A-1401, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 13 14 The board, designated as the administrators of such 15 funds, other than federal impact aid, as may be allotted to the **16** State under federal legislation for public educational purposes, **17** subject to such limitations as may be imposed by congressional action, shall use and expend the funds: 18 19 To improve the program of the public schools of the (1)20 State, including any grades up to the fourteenth grade 21 or such lower grade as shall be prescribed as a

maximum for such purposes by the Act of Congress
