
### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many of our state
- 2 and county roads are in disrepair. Drivers pay, on average,
- 3 \$400 each year to repair damage to their vehicles caused by
- 4 neglected and unmaintained roads.
- Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate 5
- funds necessary to repair state roads and to incentivize the 6
- 7 repair of county roads and highways.
- There is appropriated out of the general 8 SECTION 2.
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$10,000,000 or so
- much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for 10
- the repair and repaving of state highways and roads. 11
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 12
- 13 transportation for the purposes of this Act.
- There is appropriated out of the general 14 SECTION 3.
- revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$9,000,000 or so much 15
- thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for a 16
- grant-in-aid to the several counties for the repair and repaving 17
- of county roads and to be allocated as follows: 18

    in its 2013-2014 budget. Only funds that are appropriated for

    repair and repaving of county roads in a county's 2014-2015
    budget that are in excess of the 2013-2014 budget amount shall

    qualify for the state matching funds appropriated in this Act.

    Furthermore, notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, any

    state matching funds appropriated under this section not

    released by the director of finance or encumbered by a
    respective county by June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.

## H.B. NO. 2428

1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the respective 2 counties for the purposes of this Act. 3 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$10,000,000 or so 4 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for a 5 6 grant-in-aid to the city and county of Honolulu for the repair 7 and repaving of city and county of Honolulu roads; provided that no funds shall be made available to the city and county of 8 Honolulu unless the city and county of Honolulu provides 9 matching funds equal to the amount appropriated for the purposes 10 of this Act; provided further that the director of finance shall 11 12 not release state matching funds appropriated by this Act until all of the city and county of Honolulu's matching funds are 13 encumbered by the city and county of Honolulu. 14 In addition to the matching requirement established in this 15 16 section, in order to qualify for the state matching funds as appropriated by this Act, the city and county of Honolulu shall 17 appropriate funds for the repair and repaving of city and county 18 of Honolulu roads in an amount that exceeds the amount 19 appropriated by the city and county of Honolulu for this purpose 20 in its 2013-2014 budget. Only funds that are appropriated for 21 repair and repaving of county roads in the city and county of 22



- 1 Honolulu's 2014-2015 budget that are in excess of the 2013-2014
- 2 budget amount shall qualify for the state matching funds
- 3 appropriated in this Act. Furthermore, notwithstanding any
- 4 other law to the contrary, any state matching funds appropriated
- 5 under this section not released by the director of finance or
- 6 encumbered by the city and county of Honolulu by June 30, 2016,
- 7 shall lapse as of that date.
- 8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the city and
- 9 county of Honolulu for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
