A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. One of the missions of the department of 2 business, economic development, and tourism is to promote 3 industrial development and economic diversification by 4 supporting existing and emerging industries, increasing exports 5 of Hawaii products, and expanding Hawaii's participation in 6 global trade and commerce. The department has prepared a 7 statewide comprehensive economic development strategy. The strategy's report for the island of Hawaii found that, because 8 of the island's strong orientation toward diversified 9 10 agriculture, development of a central marketing facility for collection, consolidation, packing, and shipping of products 11 12 continues to be a priority. As a means of achieving this 13 priority, agricultural exporters have expressed interest in 14 utilizing the relatively unused foreign trade zone no. 9 located 15 in Hilo.

16 The legislature also recognizes that agriculture is and has 17 been a major economic driver of the county of Hawaii. To 18 preserve this economic driver and increase its value, the HB HMS 2014-1214 Page 2

8	The purpose of this Act is to authorize the department of		
9	business, economic development, and tourism, in collaboration		
10	with the department of agriculture to:		
11	(1) Perform planning and feasibility studies for one or		
12	more quarantine inspection, quarantine treatment,		
13	deconsolidation, and consolidation facilities on the		
14	island of Hawaii; and		
15	(2) Perform a marketing and economic impact analysis for		
16	one or more of the facilities.		
17	SECTION 2. (a) The department of business, economic		
18	development, and tourism, in collaboration with the department		
19	Of agriculture, is authorized to:		
20	(1) Perform planning and feasibility studies for one or		
21	more quarantine inspection, quarantine treatment,		



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1		deconsolidation, and consolidation facilities on the	
2		island of Hawaii; and	
3	. (2)	Perform a marketing and economic impact analysis for	
4		one or more of the facilities.	
5	(b)	The studies and analysis shall include, in addition to	
6	foreign t	rade zone no. 9 in Hilo, the following alternative	
7	locations:		
8	(1)	The land parcel managed by the department of business,	
9		economic development, and tourism currently housing	
10		the foreign trade zone neighboring the Hilo	
11		International Airport; and	
12	(2)	On the west side of the island, the Kawaihae Harbor	
13		area that is proposed for biosecurity facilities by	
14		the department of transportation, harbors division.	
15	SECT	ION 3. The department of business, economic	
16	development, and tourism shall submit a report to the		
17	legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of		
18	the regular session of 2015 on the status of the planning and		
19	feasibility study, and marketing and economic analysis, for one		
20	or more facilities on the island of Hawaii to be used for		
21	quarantine inspection, quarantine treatment, deconsolidation,		
22	and consolidation of incoming and outgoing agricultural		
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commodities. The report shall also contain recommendations and
propose necessary legislation, if any, to achieve the purpose of
this Act.

SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general 4 5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much 6 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 for 7 planning, marketing, and economic analysis for one or more 8 facilities on the island of Hawaii to be used for quarantine 9 inspection, quarantine treatment, deconsolidation, and 10 consolidation of incoming and outgoing agricultural commodities. 11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 12 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of 13 this Act.

14 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
